PRO KABADDI LEAGUE TEAM SNAPSHOTS



Bengal Warriorz are the 2019 Champions of the Pro Kabaddi League (PKL). They are owned by Capri Global Holdings. The Founder, Rajesh Sharma is the Managing Director for Capri Global Capital, a listed NBFC. Jinisha Sharma, is the Director of Capri Sports, and Apury Gupta is the CEO for Bengal Warriorz. Bollywood superstar, Akshay Kumar is a co-owner of Bengal Warriorz franchise. The team is one of the initial eight teams in the PKL since Season 1, having finished 3rd in Season 5 in 2017 and 4th just a season before in 2016.



Owned by WL League Pvt Ltd, the Bengaluru Bulls have participated in each of the PKL seasons so far. Kirthi Muralikrishnan is the CEO at Bengaluru Bulls. The franchise won the PKL title in Season 6 and finished as runners-up in Season 2. The team will be aiming for their second title under the watchful eyes of new Head Coach BC Ramesh in Season 12.



The Dabang Delhi K.C. franchise is owned by DolT Sports Management (India) Pvt Ltd, founded by Mrs. Radha Kapoor, Indian businesswomen & entrepreneur. Prashant Mishra is the CEO of Dabang Delhi K.C. Hailing from the Capital city; the franchise won the Pro Kabaddi League (PKL) title in Season 8 and have finished in the upper echelons of the points table on four occasions over the last 11 seasons.



The Gujarat Giants, an Ahmedabad -based Kabaddi team owned by Adani Sportsline, have been a formidable force in the Pro Kabaddi League since their debut in 2017. Known for their rallying cry Garjega Gujarat, the team stormed into the finals in theirfirst two Backed seasons. bv Adani Sportsline's commitment nation-building, the franchise champions the growth of indigenous sports by fostering talent at the grassroots level.



Owned by JSW Sports, the Haryana Steelers made their entry in the Pro Kabaddi League in Season 5. JSW Sports is the sports arm of the JSW Group, a \$24 billion conglomerate with a presence across India, USA, South America, Europe & Africa. Parth Jindal is the Founder & Director, JSW Sports and Divyanshu Singh is the CEO, Haryana Steelers. Under the watchful eye of Manpreet Singh, they won their first PKL trophy in Season 11.



The Jaipur Pink Panthers is owned by actor and producer Abhishek Bachchan. The franchise has won the PKL title twice and finished as runners-up in Season 4. Bunty Walia is the CEO at the Jaipur Pink Panthers.



The Patna Pirates is owned by KVS Energy and Sports Limited, which is owned by Rajesh Shah. Mr. Shah has held several roles, including as Dean's Council at the Harvard Kennedy School in 2003. He has been on the boards of Ranbaxy Laboratories Ltd., Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. He was president of CII. Pawan Rana is the CEO of the most successful side in the Pro Kabaddi League - Patna Pirates recorded a hat-trick of titles after winning the third, fourth and fifth seasons. They have also qualified for the playoffs - eight out of 11 times, and reached the final in Season 11.



Puneri Paltan is owned by Insurekot Sports Pvt Ltd, which is owned by Suresh Kotak & family. ISPL is committed to promoting sports in India. Established in 2014, ISPL, through its various initiatives aims to contribute to the betterment of sports in the country. Kailash Kandpal is the CEO at Puneri Paltan. The franchise from Pune lifted its maiden PKL title in Season 10.



The Tamil Thalaivas franchise is owned by Magica Sports Ventures Pvt Ltd, which is owned by Nimmagadda Prasad - an Indian industrialist from Telangana. He has ventures in the pharmaceutical industry. Sushen Vashishth is the CEO at the Tamil Thalaivas. The team made history in Season 9 after qualifying for the playoffs for the first time.



The Telugu Titans franchise is owned by Veera Sports, led by Srinivas Sreeramaneni, Nedurumalli Gautam and Mahesh Kolli. Trinadh Reddy is the CEO at Telugu Titans. The franchise will be looking to break the first-title jinx this year under the experience of head coach Krishan Kumar Hooda in Season 12.



The U Mumba is owned by Unilazer Ventures Pvt. Ltd, which is owned by Ronnie Screwvala - Indian entrepreneur and film producer. Suhail Chandhok is the CEO at U Mumba. The franchise emerged as champions in Season 2 and as runners-up in Season 1 & 3. U Mumba returned to the playoffs in PKL 11. They will be led by head coach Rakesh Kumar in season 12.



UP Yoddhas is owned by GMR Sports, a subsidiary of GMR Group, which is a prominent Infrastructure Indian conglomerate with global footprint. guidance Under able the mentorship of Kiran Kumar Grandhi, Corporate Chairman of GMR Group and leadership of PKSV Sagar, CEO-GMR Sports, the UP Yoddhas have demonstrated remarkable success. making to the playoffs in six out of seven seasons since its inception in 2017. This impressive track record highlights the team's competitive prowess strategic and the effectiveness its leadership, of reinforcing the team's strong performance in the league.
